Getting to Bonaire, the island that *Sport Diver's* Editor-at-Large Tom Morrissey nicknamed the "dive and dine" destination in the September 2007 issue, is now just one convenient flight away from the USA, thanks to a new flight by Delta Air Lines.

The weekly Delta Air Lines flight (#371) departs Atlanta Saturdays at 10 a.m., arriving to Bonaire at 3:10 p.m. The return flight (#370) departs Bonaire Saturdays at 4:14 p.m., arriving into Atlanta at 7:55 p.m.

Passengers can choose from 16 first class or 134 coach seats to cruise in during the short four-hour flight from Atlanta, GA to Bonaire. Passengers will also enjoy Delta's in-flight entertainment which offers a variety of Hollywood's latest blockbuster hits.

Once landed in Bonaire, visitors will be free to enjoy the Island's star attraction: scuba diving. Consistently voted as one of the top five dive destinations in the world, the fringe reef island boasts 86 marked dive sites, year-round underwater visibility of 100 feet, and diving 24 hours a day. All of the diving takes place inside of the Bonaire National Marine Park, which was founded in 1979 and extends from the high water mark to the 200-foot depth contour, all the way around the island and the uninhabited Klein Bonaire, encompassing an area of about 667 acres.

Additionally, Bonaire offers a variety of eco adventure activities including snorkeling, windsurfing, kiteboarding, landsailing, mountain biking, sea and mangrove kayaking, horseback riding, nature tours, hiking, bird watching, sailing and deep sea and bone fishing. And with a selection of accommodations ranging from full-service oceanfront resorts and condominiums to guesthouses and small inns, Bonaire has something for every lifestyle and budget.
